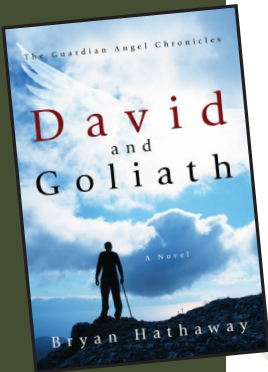


Bryan Hathaway
